Notice of Rule Change to members of the American Wagyu Association

The Board of Directors met on June 27, 2023, and approved a rule change regarding the "First Owner" definition.

The Current Rule definition is:

- **First Owner:** The first owner of a calf is the owner of record or one of not more than three (3) co-owners of record of its dam on the date of birth of the calf except in the case of embryo calves as provided for in Section I Rule 4. The first owner must apply for registration of the calf, and the dam must be officially entered on the records of the Association under the exact same name as the first owner's membership on the date of birth of the calf, except in cases of embryo calves as provided for in Section I Rule 4.

Beginning August 1, 2023, the AWA rule definition of "first owner" will read as follows:

- **First Owner:** The first owner of an animal is the member initially applying to the Association for registration of said animal. The first Owner may include up to three (3) co-owners.

More information regarding this rule change will be forthcoming prior to August 1, 2023. This rule change holds significant importance, prompting the Board of Directors to prioritize promptly informing the membership about the update.

Option on collecting bulls in Canada at:
DMV GenetiQ Services or sending them south of the border to Hawkeye Breeders Service in Iowa.

We have personally worked with and collected bulls at both facilities.

All bulls are tested for entry into AI collection (they should all qualify for export to the EU) and will be fertility tested prior to July 7.

These bulls will be able to enter AI immediately after the sale. Full list of countries semen can be exportable from Canadian collection facility: <https://inspection.canada.ca/animal-health/terrestrial-animals/exports/semen/eng/1369629077115/1369688568770>

On July 6, we will have a tour to visit Fradon and have both Adam Haight of Kirkton Veterinary Clinic and Jonathan LeHouiller of DMV speak about the services they offer.

You will be able to speak with them including Frank and Jimmy Donkers about any questions you may have.

We are able to export these animals to the EU / UK, however the export window opens December 1 and closes May 15.

If you are wanting these animals in the EU / UK, they will not be able to leave Wagyu Sekai (as any animals leaving the premises will not be eligible for export due to risk of disease and the testing required to re-obtain "EU / UK health status".

As for the exporting of collected embryos / semen from Canada, there are options of doing "piggyback shipments" via Semex / Alta Genetics or we can assist in doing whole shipments ourselves.

Regardless, we have you looked after.
