THE JUDGING PANEL



CATHERINE BROWN

Catherine joins us from the west coast where she and her husband manage a purebred and commercial herd of Hereford and Hereford-influence cattle at Copper Creek Ranch.

She has been a lifetime in the industry, is passionate about herd building and working with cows and working with her husband Phil and daughter Cayley in the art of developing show cattle, not least of which is doing what she calls that “show cattle dance” which she has done in showings across Canada.

While studying English and Journalism in University, she always kept her hand in cattle work. Her schooling led her to write and edit for livestock publications for 35 years in Ontario and across the country, including the Canadian Hereford Digest. As she works at Copper Creek Ranch, in Princeton, BC, she now also works on her first book project.

A 4-H leader for years and a former junior Hereford Association adult advisor, Catherine has judged numerous junior and beef cattle shows across Canada, including Toronto’s Royal Winter Fair and Regina’s Agribition, having been honoured to be a panel judge in the coveted RBC Beef Supreme Challenge in 2007.

Catherine describes showmanship not so much as a competition but rather more of a refined exercise in stockmanship combined with courtesy for our fellow showpeople, believing that that is what it all boils down to.



KURT AND JENN DUNCAN

Kurt Duncan along with his wife Jenn and daughters Kinley and Karly are the junior partners in Duncan Livestock in Cornwall, PE with Kurt’s parents, Karl & Irene Duncan.

Duncan Livestock calves 40-50 cows per year with most of the cow herd being bred artificially to Black Angus and Club Calf sires. All prospect steers and heifers are offered for sale at their annual sale held on the Labour Day weekend.

Kurt, individually and with Jenn have judged junior, 4-H, market, and open breed shows in the Maritimes, Quebec, and Ontario. Among the highlights of those shows are Expo Boeuf (Victoriaville) Hereford Show, Bonanza (National Junior Hereford Show), National YCS Show (Simmental), Ontario YCS (Simmental) Show, Provincial 4H Shows in New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, and PEI.

Brian and Dora have successfully shown purebred seedstock and market cattle for 50 years. They have been honoured to judge 4-H shows and beef shows together (and mostly agreeing) at about 35 shows across Eastern Canada.

The have been volunteers for 4-H members, community and agricultural organizations. They have provided over 200 4-H beef projects for members (fun times).

Dora was a school teacher for 32 years and Brian has been a director and adjuster for PEI Mutual Insurance for 25 years.

Dale MacPhee, Atlantic Regional Sales Manager for EastGen, has been involved in the A.I Industry for over 30 years. His long history with bovine genetics includes over 16 years of providing education and sales knowledge to farmers in Eastern Ontario, prior to moving in 2008 to the Atlantic Canada region. His love for the industry includes decades of involvement with 4-H, and strong roots in his family farm of purebred, Shorthorn cattle in rural Nova Scotia. Dale, along with his wife Sharon and three young adult children currently reside in Moncton, New Brunswick.

His early years of 4-H helped him develop a strong interest in genetics along with the fitting and exhibiting of beef cattle. Over the years, Dale has been fortunate to work with great beef cattle producers to help prepare and exhibit cattle at local shows and as well at the Royal, Agribition, Farmfair, and the North American International Livestock Exposition (N.A.I.L.E). One

of his fondest memories was in 1991 where he helped fit and exhibit the Supreme, Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Shorthorn Female at the R.A.W.F. National Shorthorn Show.

Having experienced Bonanza with her own children, Sharon loves the programs and opportunities it gives participants in terms of skill development and of community building. She is happy to stand behind opportunities for youth in our industry, to allow them to hone their gifts and develop a sense of self within the wider world of cattle production, livestock and agriculture.

She has always recognized the value of goal-setting opportunities of livestock-related competition and cooperation in a unique, mentor-led organization to be something very unique to our industry in terms of the holistic and ground-roots experience it affords our youth.

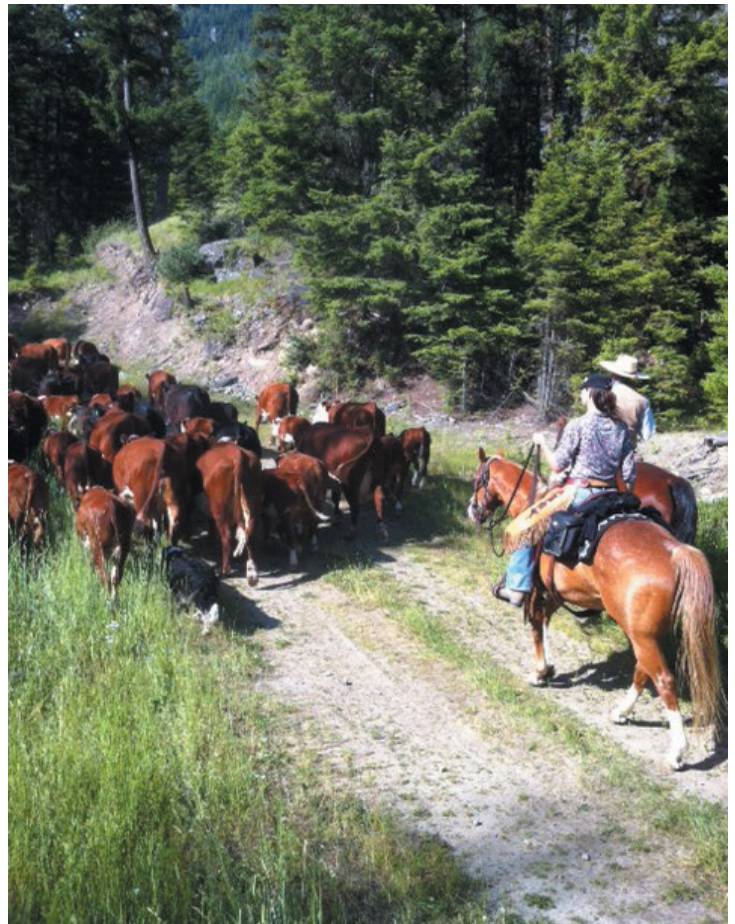
Copper Creek Ranch was established in 1999, at the turn of the century, based on a large herd of Herefords – the breed that Sharon grew up with. It has evolved since then, from 1,000 cows to its current 300-cow herd which is one-third purebred, registered Hereford and two-thirds Hereford-influence commercial. Catherine and Phil Brown have managed the operation into its second decade with a focus on fine tuning management protocols and building cow families.

They oversee a staff of four – Bob (irrigation, maintenance & forage harvesting); Cole (crop and field development, resource management & winter feeding); Shawn (cowboy, talented multi-tasker and fencer); and Liam (fencer and ranch hand).

CCR purebreds are marketed nationally and internationally while Hereford bulls are sold into local commercial herds. Cattle graze 170,000 acres of rangeland – a space that is managed responsibly, alongside with wildlife and their habitats and the operations of local logging companies. The logging roads provide the pathways through those rugged mountain ranges which are very unique to the province of BC.

CCR calves have consistently topped commercial calf markets for the past few years and which are in demand from local meat purveyors. Their beef is sold into reputation butcher shops in the Fraser Valley and they are currently developing a beef trade locally, for both grain-fed and grass-fed streams.

Copper Creek Ranch is now developing an organic, regenerative forage production program with the focus on generations to follow.

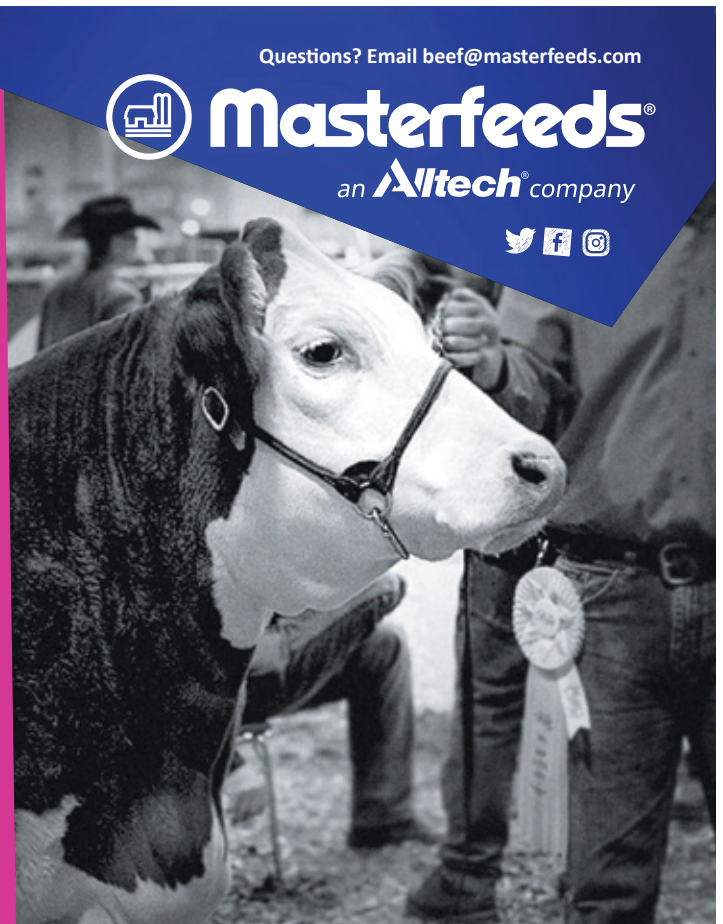

BONANZA RULES & REGULATIONS

GENERAL INFORMATION

Age Division as of January 1, 2023 Mini Herfs under 5
Pee Wee 5 - 8
Junior 9 - 12
Intermediate 13 - 16
Senior 17 - 21
CJHA membership terminates on the 31st of December following your 22nd birthday.

HEALTH REGULATIONS

All provincial health regulations in effect during the week of Bonanza will be followed.

MINI- HERFS:

Are active CJHA members who are under 5 years of age as of January 1st. Mini-Herfs are allowed to participate in all non-livestock events. Special activities and events will be planned daily for this age group.

Bob Gordon Memorial Award/Grand Aggregate Competition Points will be awarded for participation and individual competition results at Bonanza, which includes the conformation classes, individual skill competitions, and photo/art & literature competitions. 0.5 points are awarded for each animal registered. An additional 2 points per head is awarded for each animal registered that is qualified as "Bred & Owned", up to a maximum of 3 head. In order for points to qualify for the Aggregate, a minimum of 2, of the 4 Individual competitions, must be entered. Points earned in all 4 Individual competitions will count towards the Aggregate.

PREMIER BREEDER COMPETITION

The Premier Breeder award will be awarded to the Bonanza participant whose bred animals accumulate the highest number of points based upon their highest six placings in the Open Show. The participant must be listed as the breeder of the exhibited animal. Points will be calculated based on show rules. A participant who buys and shows an animal from another CJHA member can accumulate points for the original breeder, given that they are also a Bonanza participant.

INDIVIDUAL JUDGING COMPETITION

Open to four age divisions: Pee Wee, Junior, Intermediate and Senior. Time will be limited to 15 minutes for each class of animals. Placings and written reasons will be judged using the Hormel system. Oral reasons will be limited to three minutes. Judging cards may be used while giving oral reasons. Scoring: Judging card 50%; oral reasons 50%. A scribe will be provided for participants that are unable to write their own judging cards. Top will be invited to compete in the Team Judging competition. Must be pre-selected on entry form. No changes will be allowed at registration.

TEAM JUDGING COMPETITION

Must be pre-selected on entry form. Three age divisions: Junior, Intermediate and Senior. Teams of two (an acting judge and a ring person) from each age division compete to place a class. The ring person will work the ring and the judge will evaluate a class of four cattle and give oral reasons for placings on the microphone. There will be a 15-minute time limit on the class.

LITTLE LEAGUE GROOMING

Must be pre-selected on entry form. Teams consisting of two Pee Wee members. Teams have the option to nominate a maximum of one junior age division member to act as an advisor. The advisor cannot groom. The team must groom one animal in 10 minutes, and then display the groomed animal in the show ring for the completion of judging. Blowers will be allowed in the Little League Grooming Competition, but clippers will not be allowed.

INDIVIDUAL SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Open to four age divisions: Pee Wee, Junior, Intermediate and Senior. A participant may use other exhibitor's animals. Must be pre-selected on the entry form, no changes will be allowed at registration. *****NO BULL CALVES, YEARLINGS, OR 2 YEAR OLDS ALLOWED IN SHOWMANSHIP***NO EXCEPTIONS*****

INDIVIDUAL GROOMING COMPETITION

Open to four age divisions: Pee Wee, Junior, Intermediate and Senior. Pee Wees will have 10 minutes and all other age divisions will have 15 minutes to groom. Animals must be brought to the competition only having been clipped and washed. If any products are detected on the animal prior to competition, this will result in disqualification. Pee Wee & Junior participant's animals must enter the chute wearing a show halter. Intermediate and senior participant's animals must enter the chute wearing a rope halter. Power and a blower will be provided. (Clippers are allowed). Must be pre-selected on entry form. No changes will be allowed at registration.

TEAM GROOMING COMPETITION

Teams will be made up of one participant from each age category: senior, intermediate and junior. Teams will be provided with power and a blower (clippers are allowed). Teams will have 15 minutes to fit one animal for the show ring. Animals must be brought to the competition only having been clipped and washed. If any products are detected on the animal prior to competition, this will result in disqualification. Animals must enter the chute wearing a rope halter.

TEAM MARKETING COMPETITION

Open to all Bonanza participants. Teams will consist of three participants of any age. At least two members must speak during the presentation. Presentations are to be three to six minutes long. The objective of the competition is to encourage

team participation, communication skills, marketing skills and a general knowledge of the selling points of an animal. An animal may be picked by the marketing team, or one may be provided. The marketing team must convince three judges to purchase.

The animal based on pedigree, performance information and phenotype. But other criteria may be used. Points will be awarded for knowledge, creativity, salesmanship and originality.

Teams should provide the judges with a copy of the animal's registration certificate. Judges are able to ask questions. Teams will be penalized for using any notes.

PUBLIC SPEAKING COMPETITION

Open to age divisions: Pee Wee, Junior, Intermediate and Senior. Speeches are to be prepared or impromptu. Prepared topics are below. Juniors must choose only one type of speech - either prepared or impromptu. Time limits per speech: Pee Wee: 1- 2 minutes; Juniors: 2-3 minutes; Intermediates: 3-4 minutes and Seniors: 4-6 minutes. Topic must be on Agriculture. No changes will be allowed at registration.

MAJOR JAY FOX AMBASSADOR AWARD

This award is presented by Justamere Ranches and the Fox Families, to Bonanza participants who abide by ethical and showmanship standards, who show a kind spirit and who willingly help their fellow competitors whenever the need arises, acting as honorable ambassadors for their group. CJHA members will nominate two Bonanza participants, one from their age division, and one from outside their age division. Final selections will be chosen by the Adult Advisors and one member of the Fox family or a designated representative at the end of the event. Awards will be presented to each age division with one overall Ambassador Award presented.

PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION

Open to all CJHA members. Photos may be mailed if the member is unable to attend. There will be five age divisions. Each member may only submit one photo per Section. The photo must have been taken by the entrant himself/herself. Photos no larger than 5"x7" will be accepted. No frames or borders allowed photos only.

Section A: Hereford cattle only

Section B: Hereford cattle with 1+ person or selfie

Section C: Commercial Hereford Event

HEREFORD ART COMPETITION

Open to all CJHA members. Art may be mailed if the member is unable to attend. There will be five age divisions. Each member may only submit one piece of art per section. The art must have been created by the entrant. Artwork to depict the theme of Hereford Cattle.

Section A: Advertisement - Cattle Sale, Event or Magazine

Section B: Collage

Section C: Hand Drawn

Section D: Medium of your choice

LITERATURE COMPETITION

Open to all CJHA members. Literature may be mailed if the member is unable to attend. There will be five age divisions. Each member may only submit one piece of literature per section. The literature must have been created by the entrant. Literature to depict or involve the theme of Hereford Cattle.

Section A: Poem

Section B: Report about an event or true story
(2000 words or less)

Section C: Fiction/Short Story (2000 words or less)

SCRAPBOOK COMPETITION

The scrapbook contest is to encourage CJHA members to keep a record of the livestock or agricultural events they have attended over the past year. The scrapbook may also illustrate what life is like on their own family's farm or ranch operation year-round. Entrants should carry one theme throughout the entire scrapbook, including photos and captions or written sections to describe what is happening. Scrapbooks should have a title page and can include an index with page numbers. They should include newspaper articles or media clippings. Scrapbooks will be judged on their relevance to the theme, on neatness and on creativity.

ADVERTISING COMPETITION FOR 2023

Design a one-page advertisement (digital) to be placed in the Canadian Hereford Digest to promote Roots & Wings Farm. This competition is open to individual or teams of up to 3 juniors. Juniors must contact Ian McNaughton email: ian.mcnaughton@homehardware.ca or phone (705) 394-7770 to receive photographs and other essential information necessary for the advertisement. The advertisement entry, along with a 250 words or less written explanation of the marketing strategy used in the design of the advertisement must be completed and submitted to Roots & Wings Farms via email by JULY 19, 2023. Judging will be completed before Bonanza starts and the winner will be announced at Bonanza. This competition is open to all active CJHA members (2023 Activity fees paid). The winner(s) will receive a \$250 Cash Prize. The ad must conform to the following Digest specs: Page size is 8.25" by 10.75". Plus, a ¼" inch bleed around all sides. The live area is 7.25" by 9.75". (Hint: don't put anything important too close to the edge of the page or it may get cut off when the magazine is trimmed.)

PROVINCIAL BOOTH COMPETITION

Each province will be given a table to decorate as they see fit. This must include a provincial basket, a physical or digital scrapbook, or photo display, and identifiable provincial items and promotional material.

BONANZA GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

Bonanza is a CHA sanctioned MOE Show and follows MOE show rules where applicable.

1. Bonanza is open to all Junior Hereford Association members from Canada or from foreign countries who are registered members of their respective Hereford Associations. **Canadian members must have paid their annual \$25.00 activity fee before entries can be processed. Members must pay their activity fee by entry deadline, in order to be eligible to participate. 2023 CJHA Activity fee must be paid before registration! CJHA Activity fee and membership MUST be paid to the CHA office and not to the Bonanza Committee.**
2. Bonanza participants are encouraged to enter as many competitions as possible. Points are awarded for participation and individual competition results, which includes the confirmation classes, individual skill competitions, and photo/art & literature competitions. These points are used to determine the Bob Gordon Memorial/Aggregate Award (details above). Bonanza participants must participate in at least two of the following competitions to be eligible for the Grand Aggregate competition: Individual Showmanship, Individual Grooming, Public Speaking, and Individual Judging.
3. **Cattle entry fee:** \$75 per single animal entered. Initial bedding will be provided and included in this fee. Cow/Calf entries will be considered one entry unless the calf is also entered separately in a calf class. There is no entry fee for group classes or individual and team competitions. When an animal is entered in the Open show, as well as the Semen donation and/or Bred and Owned show, they will only pay one entry fee. **Entries are processed only after payment in full is received. Therefore, if payment is received after June 1st, late entry fees will apply. If payment is not received by June 15th entries will be discarded.**
4. The **ENTRY DEADLINE is June 1st, 2023**. Late entries will be accepted up until June 15th at the latest. (Late entry fee is \$100 from June 1st – June 15th, 2023) All entries postmarked after this date will not be accepted.
5. **Substitutions** will be allowed until June 15th, 2023 for an additional fee of \$100. No substitutions will be allowed after this date.
6. All purebred Hereford entries must include **Proof of Registration**, please provide the registration number. Entries which are not accompanied by proof of registration will not be accepted and the entry fee forfeited. If a registration is pending, this must be declared on the entry form. However, all purebred Herefords must be registered by the start of Bonanza and proof of registration must be provided at the registration desk. All purebred entries must have a legible tattoo that will be confirmed when the cattle are weighed. Weights and EPDs must be displayed on each animal's stall card as per MOE show rules. Scrotal measurements will be done as per MOE show rules. Weight cards will be distributed at Bonanza 2023.
7. The Bonanza Open and Bred and Owned Shows will adhere to current Canadian Hereford Association MOE rules. The rules can be found at www.hereford.ca/moe.php
8. All animals must have an RFID tag in place.
9. An animal is considered eligible in the Bonanza **Bred and Owned** show, if the Breeder ID number (registered as a junior membership) is the SAME as the Owner ID number (registered as a junior membership). Note: If the CJHA membership involves two or more juniors (Partnership) eligibility of bred and owned animals within the partnership will end when the oldest partner ages out of the CJHA. For this reason, members are encouraged to take out single CJHA memberships and register their cattle under their own name if they intend to participate and show in Bonanza.
10. An animal that is entered in a **Semen Donation** class must be bred by the exhibitor, be sired by a bull whose semen was awarded through the CJHA's Semen Donation Program and be out of the dam which was nominated for the program by the member himself/herself.
11. **Heifer Lottery Show Rules & Eligibility**
 - A. The heifer must be purchased from a recognized CJHA Heifer Lottery Sale or Breeder at the year of purchase.
 - B. The female must be transferred into a Junior membership. The CJHA discourages transfer into junior partnerships (no longer available). Any partnership with an adult membership or commercial designation will be ineligible for competition.
 - C. Proof of purchase (copy of bill of sale) must be included in entries to the Heifer Lottery Show Committee (Bonanza Committee)
 - D. Females may not be purchased and transferred from direct relatives or family herds.
 - E. A Junior membership may only enter one animal per division in the CJHA Heifer Lottery Show.
 - F. The CJHA Heifer Lottery Show will consist of the following Purebred divisions: Heifer Calf, Yearling Heifer and 2-Year-Old Cow with Calf and Hereford-Plus divisions: Heifer Calf, Yearling Heifer and 2-Year-Old Cow with Calf.
12. **Commercial cattle** entries must be accompanied by a photograph of the animal and their RFID tag number. Cattle must exhibit strong Hereford characteristics, including but not limited to, white on the face and belly. The Bonanza show committee and entry taker will decide eligibility of each entry based on the photograph, upon receipt of the registration. Entries which are not accompanied by a photo and RFID number, or entries that are determined not to display adequate Hereford

characteristics, will be disqualified and the entry fee returned. Commercial entries are eligible to be shown in the Commercial and Market Steer classes as well as in Showmanship and Grooming classes. All commercial bull calves must be castrated to be eligible to be shown.

13. **Tampering** with cattle is strictly prohibited.
14. All animals must be broke to lead. All yearling and two-year-old bulls must be handled with a ring at all times. Humbugs will only be permitted on bull calves. As per the MOE rules, the scrotal circumference is taken at the show for all bulls.
15. Cattle may arrive after 8am on **Tuesday, July 25th, 2023 in tie outs**. All cattle must be stalled in the barn by 8:00 am on **Wednesday, July 26th, 2023**. Cattle will be released following the conclusion of the show on **Saturday, July 29th, 2023**. Cattle must be off the grounds by 2 p.m. on **Sunday, July 30th, 2023**. **Cattle cannot leave grounds after arrival unless given permission to do so by a designated vet, otherwise they will be disqualified from the show. (Vet info will be posted in cattle building)**
16. Initial bedding/shavings will be provided. Bedding at tie outs will be supplied.
17. All animals will be stalled by family/Farm. Stalling will be assigned by the Bonanza Committee. For requests, you must specify on entry form. No farm/breeder signs allowed.
18. The Bonanza committee reserves the right to determine eligibility of all entries based on show rules and requirements.
19. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, DRUGS, SMOKING, OR VAPING WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BARN OR AT COMPETITIONS.**
20. **Nurse cow pens** are only available for cows not being shown in Bonanza. A flat fee of \$50 per pen will be charged to cover gate rentals and bedding for the entire week.
21. **Health Requirements.** All animals must be free of any transmissible or zoonotic disease. Any animal showing signs of infection will be inspected by a veterinarian and will be dealt with accordingly at the expense of the owner.
22. Copies of all photography, art and literature entries become the property of the CJHA. The originals must be picked up by entrants by 9 p.m. on Saturday, July 29th, 2023.
23. Pee Wee participants may only show yearling heifers, steers or calendar year heifer calves. Pee Wee participants **MUST** be accompanied in the ring by an intermediate or senior member at all times.
24. Bonanza 2023 will allow the use of aerosols.
25. All members are required to wear their show shirt for all competitions, Opening Ceremonies and the group photo. No ball caps will be permitted in the show ring or the opening ceremonies. Cowboy hats are permitted.
26. Only Registered, Bonanza participants are permitted to groom (wash, blow, clip, etc.) or fit cattle at Bonanza.

Non-juniors may assist with stall set-up, clean-up, feeding, watering, and walking animals, while the associated Junior member(s) is actively participating in the activity. Bonanza encourages youth to take responsibility for the care and preparation of cattle without adult or professional help. The safety of all participants, spectators and animals takes precedence in situations when adult intervention is required. Juniors that are involved in any infraction will be given ONE warning by the CJHA Adult Advisor's. If found to have another infraction that junior will be Disqualified from the Grand Aggregate Competition.

27. Tie-outs- Cattle can be released to tie-outs after 5 p.m. or end of show. Neck ties are mandatory at tie-outs.
28. All Bonanza rules will be enforced by the Adult Advisors.

Today the CJHA still hosts one of the largest junior events, called Bonanza, across the Canadian provinces. These two projects enable CJHA members opportunities to access sought-after genetics while building their personal herds. These projects are available to active juniors through the generosity and support of CHA members that are the foundation of our junior program.

BRED & OWNED SHOW

An opportunity for juniors to showcase their breeding program. Animals' eligible for the Bred & Owned Show, typically must have the Breeder ID and the Owner ID listed as the same junior membership.

SEMEN DONATION SHOW

Animals exhibited in this show must be sired by bulls, whose semen has been donated to the junior breeder through the Semen Donation Project. This CJHA project is a unique opportunity for juniors to have access to sought-after bull genetics at a fraction of the commercial cost.

HEIFER LOTTERY SHOW

This is a female show where juniors can show off their cattle acquired through purchase from sanctioned Heifer Lottery Sales & Breeders across Canada. Canadian Hereford breeders have responded with great support of this project, which has enabled the CJHA to provide its active members with more opportunities to win a Heifer Lottery Voucher to purchase that special heifer at a discounted price! With or without a voucher, juniors can purchase females from these sales, have them transferred to their junior membership, and participate in the Heifer Lottery Show at Bonanza.
